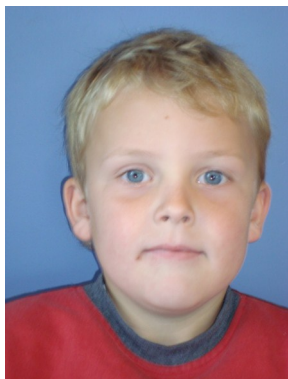

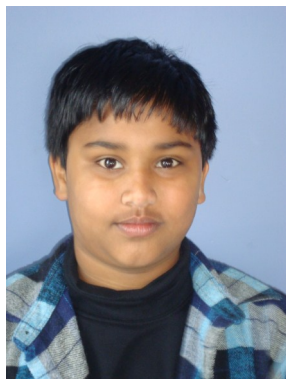

## NZ Junior Boys Champion



Well done to **Keightley Watson**, who has just competed in the **New Zealand National Judo Championships** in Auckland, where he continued to excel through dedication and effort.

This saw him on the Podium with a Gold Medal and New Zealand Junior Boys Champion Title in the +36kg Category. He also took the Gold Medal and Title for New Zealand Open Weight Junior Boys. Along with 2 New Zealand Titles, Keightley also was awarded the Trophy Cup for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year running for New Zealand's Most Outstanding Judoka Junior Boys.

This was Keightley's final year in the Junior Boys and 2012 he moves to Senior Boys. Keightley's year finishes on a high with a nomination for Junior Sportsperson of the year, taking place on the 19<sup>th</sup> November. Keightley has his sight set on future Oceania Games.
